Clark Pinnock is Professor of Systematic Theology at McMaster Divinity College, Hamilton, Ontario, Canada. He has served as a professor at Regent College, Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, and the University of Manchester.

Dr. Pinnock is a prolific writer on theological topics and practical Christianity. He is well known for his theological reflection on the Bible, its inspiration and the nature of its authority, and for his contribution to the dialogue on inerrancy. Among his important books on the nature of Scripture are A Defense of Biblical Infallibility (Craig, 1967); Set Forth Your Case (Moody, 1971); Biblical Revelation: Foundation of Christian Theology (Moody, 1971; Presbyterian and Reformed, 1985); and The Scripture Principle (Harper & Row, 1984).
