Dr. Dallas Albert Willard is Professor and past director of the School of Philosophy at the University of Southern California. He is a Southern Baptist minister who is a graduate of William Jewell College, Tennessee Temple College, Baylor University, and the University of Wisconsin. He has been the

recipient of the "Outstanding Faculty Member" and "Excellence in Teaching" awards given for outstanding contributions to student life at USC.

Dr. Willard has written two excellent books on spirituality entitled *In Search of Guidance* (Ventura, CA: Regal Books, 1984) and *The Spirit of the Disciplines* (San Francisco: Harper and Row, 1988).

He has also produced numerous articles for such publications as the *Sunday School Lesson Illustrator*, *Christianity Today*, *The Student* and *Christian Spirituality*.
